



Year 3 & 4 Jindabyne Sport and Recreation Centre Camp 2016

Dear Parents/Carers

As advised last month, the excursion for Years 3 & 4 this year is a 3 day (2 night) Sport and Recreation Camp in Jindabyne from Wednesday 2 November until Friday 4 November (Week 4 in Term 4).

The children will be sleeping in dormitory style accommodation and will be supervised by staff from the centre and Broulee PS. Activities will include rock wall climbing, archery, canoeing, green machine bikes and cooperation games and skill building. There are enjoyable free-time and after-dinner activities to entertain the students. Attending these camps is a rewarding social and educational experience that builds confidence and independence. We are sure your child will enjoy and remember this experience for many years.

The cost includes coach transport, accommodation, all meals and snacks and tuition by professionals in all activities. As stated in the first letter, the tentative cost of \$320 is calculated on 80 students attending. A place has been reserved for all students in Years 3 and 4.

We are now seeking a \$50 deposit as confirmation of your child's attendance. The deposit will be accepted until **FRIDAY 10 JUNE**. On Tuesday 14 June a letter will be sent home to all those students who have confirmed their spot by returning the deposit detailing the exact cost, comprehensive medical forms, a list of what items to bring to camp and mobile phone policy.

A very limited amount of student assistance money is available to support families with educational expenses. Student assistance is NOT available to pay the deposit. Student assistance may be available to help with a small part of the subsequent payments. Should you wish to apply for assistance, please contact Mrs Lowe for a confidential discussion **before** you lodge the deposit. There is no guarantee that any assistance will be available.

- All cheques should be made payable to Broulee Public School.
- Cash/cheque payments should be given to the class teacher and not the front office.

NOTE: Students who consistently demonstrate unacceptable behaviour at school during the year will be subject to a risk management review. This may result in their invitation to attend this excursion being withdrawn, as self-control and cooperation are vital skills needed to ensure safety at camp.

- If you wish your child to attend this camp, complete the payment envelope and include a deposit of \$50 and return it to your child's teacher before Friday 10 June. Payments may be made by Direct Deposit (see below).
